Finding your way

Delegates travelling to the Learning and Conference Centre may wish to contact reception on 0115 872 2171 prior to arrival to confirm directions.

By road from the South

Leave M1 at Junction 25 to join the A52 to Nottingham. After five miles you will come to the A6514 (Middleton Boulevard) roundabout. Go straight across (this becomes Derby Road). On your right you will pass the Queen's Medical Centre. About 1 mile past the roundabout turn left onto Triumph Road (HA Fox Jaguar Garage is on the corner). The Learning and Conference Centre entrance barrier is situated on the left after half a mile just before the bridge.

By road from the North

Leave the M1 at Junction 26 taking the A610 to Nottingham. After approximately three miles turn right on to the A6514, Western Boulevard. At the second roundabout, turn left on to the A609 Wollaton Road. At the next set of traffic lights, turn right onto Triumph Road. The Learning and Conference Centre entrance barrier is situated on the right after half a mile just after the bridge.

By rail

Nottingham railway station is close to the city centre and has a taxi rank adjacent. The journey to the Learning and Conference Centre takes approximately 15 minutes.

By coach

Nottingham's Broadmarsh bus station has express coach services to and from London, Edinburgh and many other UK cities. The station is only a few minutes walk from the city centre.

By air

Nottingham East Midlands Airport is approximately ten miles south west of Nottingham, just off junctions 23A/24 of the M1 motorway. The journey by taxi from the airport takes approximately 30 minutes. To arrange for your complimentary transfer from the above locations to the Learning and Conference Centre contact our reception prior to arrival.
